The User expressly acknowledges having read and understood this Mandate for the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification (RHFAC) Registry (the "Registry"), and agrees to use the Registry in the manner set out therein.

By clicking "Agree" the User is agreeing to these terms which apply if the User chooses to access or use the Registry.

All intended users of this Registry are hereby informed of the Registry's limited and focused mandate relating to the listing and delisting of properties that have received assessment and/or certification by the Rick Hansen Foundation in accordance with the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program and agree to use this Registry in a manner that is consistent with, and not contrary to, the following mandate:

1. The Registry is intended to serve as a public domain for display of assessments and/or certifications that has been conferred by the Rick Hansen Foundation to facilitate transparency, accuracy, consistency, completeness and relevance in accessibility requirements.

1.1. The Registry is expected to benefit building or property owners and stakeholders by providing a platform to publicly display efforts in integrating accessibility requirements into new and existing infrastructure, as per the accessibility standards developed by the Rick Hansen Foundation.

1.2. The Registry is specifically intended to allow building or property owners to publicly account for and register:

1.3. Accessibility requirements that have been incorporated into buildings or properties in accordance with the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program ; and

1.4. The level of certification that has been achieved further to being assessed by the Rick Hansen Foundation

2. While users of the Registry may ultimately use the RHFAC Registry public registrations to benefit from some of the following applications:

2.1. corporate risk management: for example, the identification and management of risks and opportunities;

2.2. voluntary initiatives: for example, participation in the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program or other similar accessibility initiatives ;

2.3. Diversity & Inclusion initiatives: for example, the proactive inclusion of persons with diverse disabilities through various inclusiveness programs;

Users acknowledge that such uses are beyond the scope of the Registry which is designed to function strictly as a service to centrally list and publicly display buildings or properties that are consistent with the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program.

3. In accordance with the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program, the Registry constitutes a Rick Hansen Foundation Certification Program neutral framework and uses terms and concepts designed to be broadly compatible with the requirements and guidance of relevant Rick Hansen Foundation policies and programs, good practice, legislation and standards. All terms not defined herein shall be interpreted in accordance with the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program.

4. Intended users participating in the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program and using the Registry in conjunction with this program shall specifically identify the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program in their Project documents and any additional or distinct requirements associated with the same.

5. The Registry is and is intended to operate strictly as a listing and public display service for buildings and properties that are assessed and/or certified in accordance with the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program. It was created for the purpose of allowing entities to register Projects that are assessed and/or certified by the Rick Hansen Foundation in accordance with the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification Program and will be assigned serial numbers by the Registry.

CSA Group provides no services and undertakes no activities whatsoever in relation to facilitating the assessment or certification and has no commercial interest whatsoever in the delivery, assessment or certification of buildings or properties by the building or property owners, responsible parties and intended users other than the Registry listing and public display of the Projects in accordance with the instructions of the building or property owner in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Rick Hansen Foundation Registry Service Agreement.

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
